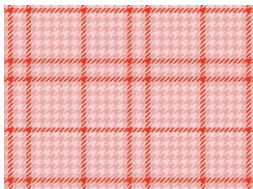

Fabric G	CMC-25407	$\frac{3}{4}$ yd.

BACKING FABRIC
CMC-25407 (Suggested)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

$\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.

Fabric A

- Cut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip.
- Subcut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric B

- Cut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip.
- Subcut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric C

- Cut 1(one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip.
- Subcut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric D

- Cut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip.
- Subcut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric E

- Cut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip.
- Subcut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric F

- Cut $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip.
- Subcut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric G

- Cut $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip.
- Subcut 1 (one) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.
- Subcut 2 (two) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16 strip.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

- Join fabrics **A-F** following the diagram below.



DIAGRAM 1

- Now, place the assembled piece on the wrong side of Fabric **G** $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.
- Pin in place.
- Measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " from the top, down and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " from the left edge, in and place your tree template, tracing it using a water soluble pen.

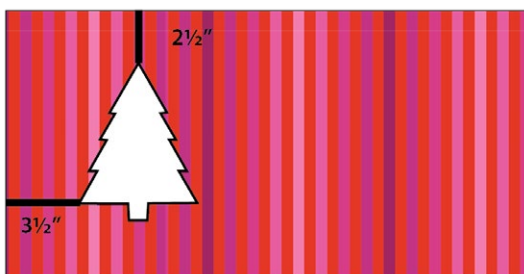


DIAGRAM 2

- Trace the next tree template $\frac{1}{2}$ " distance following the diagram below.

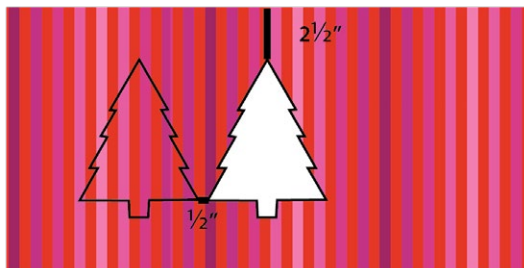


DIAGRAM 3

- Trace the next tree template $\frac{1}{2}$ " distance from the second tree tracing, following the diagram below.

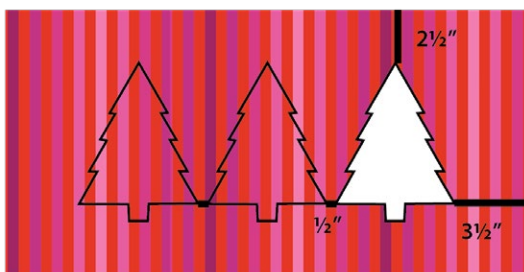


DIAGRAM 4

- Place batting fabric on the wrong side of the assembled fabric, creating a three layered piece.
- Sew along the traced lines with desired color thread. You can also quilt as desired, just make sure not to quilt inside the tree tracing.
- Take a small scissors and cut inside the tree at a $\frac{1}{8}$ " distance from your stitching to reveal the fabric beneath.



DIAGRAM 5

- Continuing revealing your Christmas trees.



DIAGRAM 6

- Take both 16 " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from Fabric **G**. And fold the right edge $\frac{1}{2}$ " towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge $\frac{1}{2}$ " again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same but this time for the left edge of the other piece.

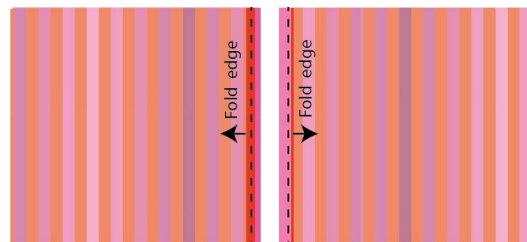


DIAGRAM 7

- Lay the quilted pillow top right side up.
- Align the raw edge of one rectangle from fabric **G**, wrong side up, to the right hand side of the pillow top. Pin in place.

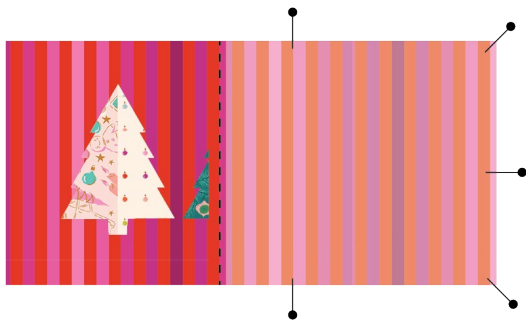


DIAGRAM 8

- Align the raw edge of the other Fabric **G** rectangle, wrong side up, to the left hand side of the pillow top. Pin in place.

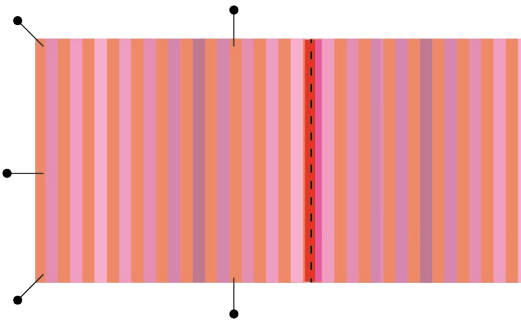
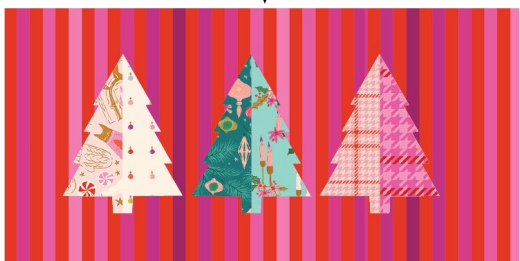
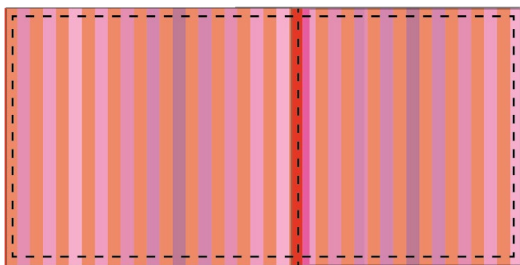


DIAGRAM 9

- Sew around the edges at $\frac{1}{4}$ ". At each corner rotate while keeping the needle down.
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric. Press.
- Fill the pillow with a 24" x 12" pillow form and enjoy!
