Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

three 15-1/2" squares centered on the motifs in the panel

From Fabric B, cut:

one 20-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 20-1/2" squares

four 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 3" x 20-1/2" rectangles

four 3" x 15-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

one 20-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 20-1/2" square

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 3" x 20-1/2" rectangles

two 3" x 15-1/2" rectangles

Assemble the Pillow Front

Step 1: Sew a 15-1/2" Fabric A square between two 3" x 15-1/2" Fabric B rectangles. Press the seams toward the rectangle.



Step 2: Sew a 3" x 20-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the top and bottom edges of the unit. Press the seams toward the rectangles to complete the Pillow Front.

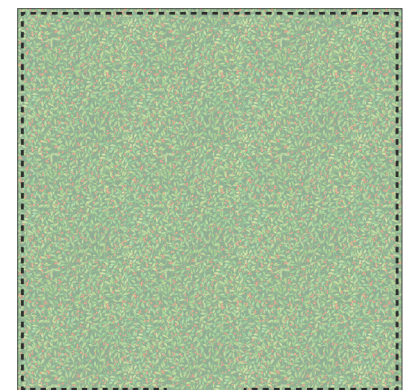


Step 3: Repeat Steps 1-2 to make two additional Pillow Fronts.



Assemble the Pillow

Step 4: Place a Pillow Front and a 20-1/2" Fabric B square right sides together. Sew around the perimeter, leaving a 4" opening for turning and backstitching at each end of the seam.



Step 5: Turn the pillow right side out through the opening. Press the edge of the pillow flat if desired.



Step 6: Stuff the pillow with polyester fiberfill.

Step 7: Whip stitch the opening closed.

Step 8: Repeat Steps 4-7 to make two additional pillows.
